

## ABC's Emphasis for the Sensory Table

- A-** Apples, acorns, aquarium gravel, toy astronauts, alphabet macaroni, plastic apes
- B-** Butterflies, beads, buttons, bubble pack, baking powder, bugs, baby dolls, brown paper bags, balls, items that are blue, items that are brown, items that are black
- C-** Cotton balls, collage materials, cheerios, cookie cutters, chalk, cornmeal, corks, candles, chalk, cardboard, craft sticks, clothespins, coffee filters, crepe paper, corn cobs, coffee stir sticks, combs
- D-** Dough, doilies, dirt, dish detergent, daubers, deodorant bottles, dried coffee grounds
- E-** Evergreen branches, egg cartons, eye droppers
- F-** Feathers, foam, felt, foil, funnels, flour, food coloring, fly swatters, film canisters
- G-** Goop, glitter, gloves, golf balls, glue, grass, items that are green
- H-** Hay, hair rollers
- I-** Ice, icing, Ivory Soap Flakes
- J-** Jewels, small plastic jars
- K-** Kitchen utensils, kidney beans, kosher salt
- L-** Lacing, leaves, liquid starch, liquid detergent
- M-** Money, mittens, masks
- N-** Nuts, numbers (plastic), noodles, names of children, newspaper scraps
- O-** Oranges, Oreos, oatmeal, items that are orange
- P-** Pumpkins, paper, play dough, pudding, packaging foam, pom poms, pipe cleaners, pillow cases, plastic animals, paint, items that are purple
- Q-** Q-tips, quilt pieces
- R-** Raffia, raisins, rice, ribbon, rubber bands, rolling pins, items that are red
- S-** Sticks, shaving cream, sequins, soil, seeds, sand, seashells, sea weed, salt, straws, sugar, sawdust, sponges, spray bottles, spools, snorkel, shovels, scoops, sieves, Saran Wrap, sifters, siphons, string
- T-** Toothpicks, twine, tongs, tweezers, twigs, items that are turquoise
- U-** Umbrellas, letter U (many of them in felt, paper, plastic, etc.)
- V-** Violins, Valentines
- W-** Water, wheels, watermelon, wood, white glue, wrapping paper, worms real and pretend,
- X-** Xylophone, X's made from paper or felt
- Y-** Yarn, items that are yellow, empty yogurt containers
- Z-** Zippers, plastic zebras, number zero, plastic zoo animals

\*\* Always check first for safety when placing items in your sensory table.
