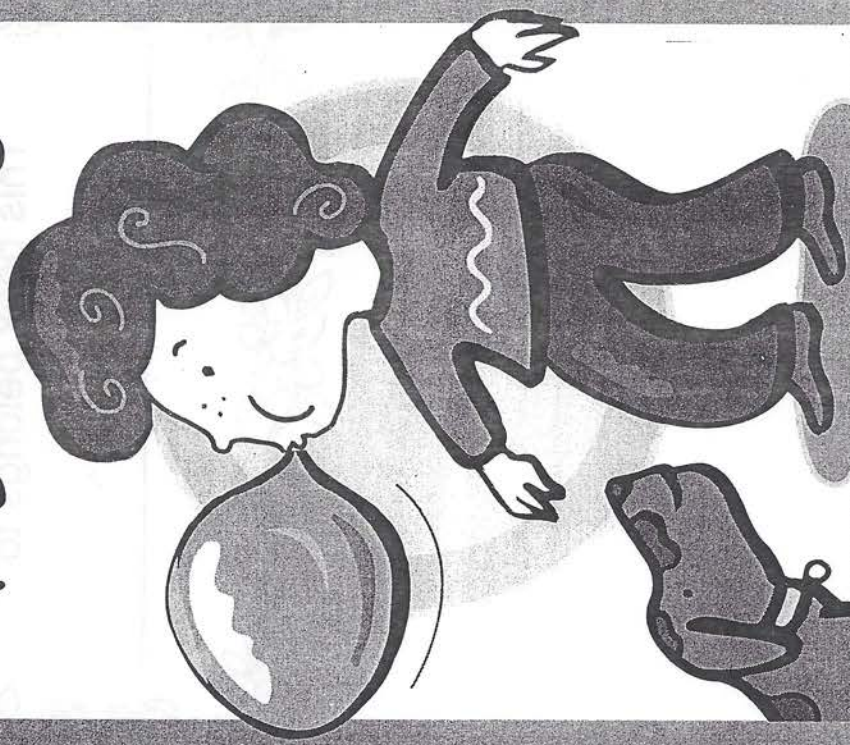

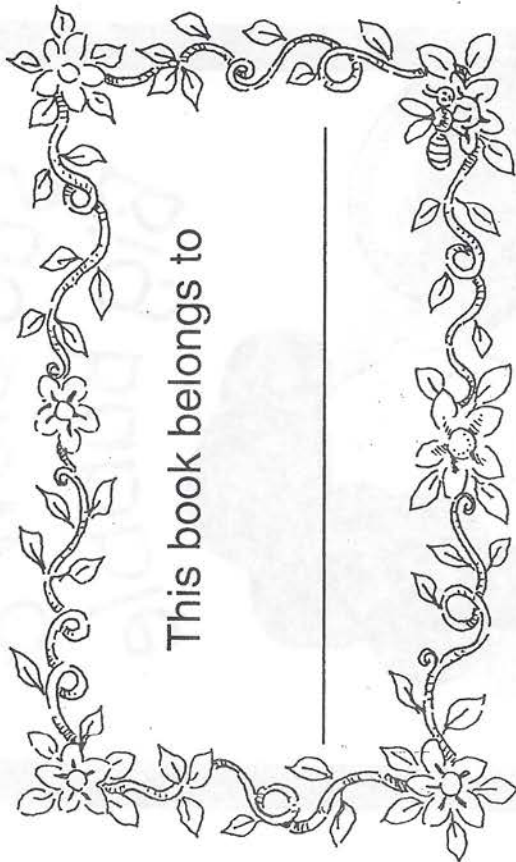

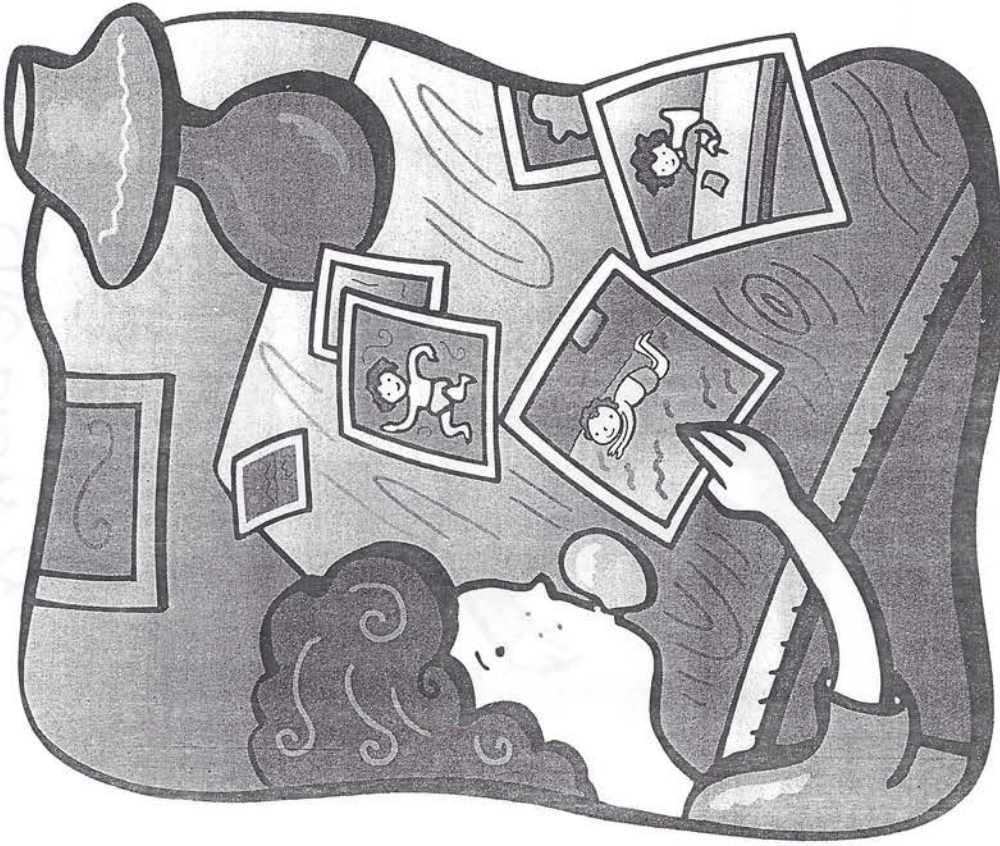

And she can blow a bubble too.

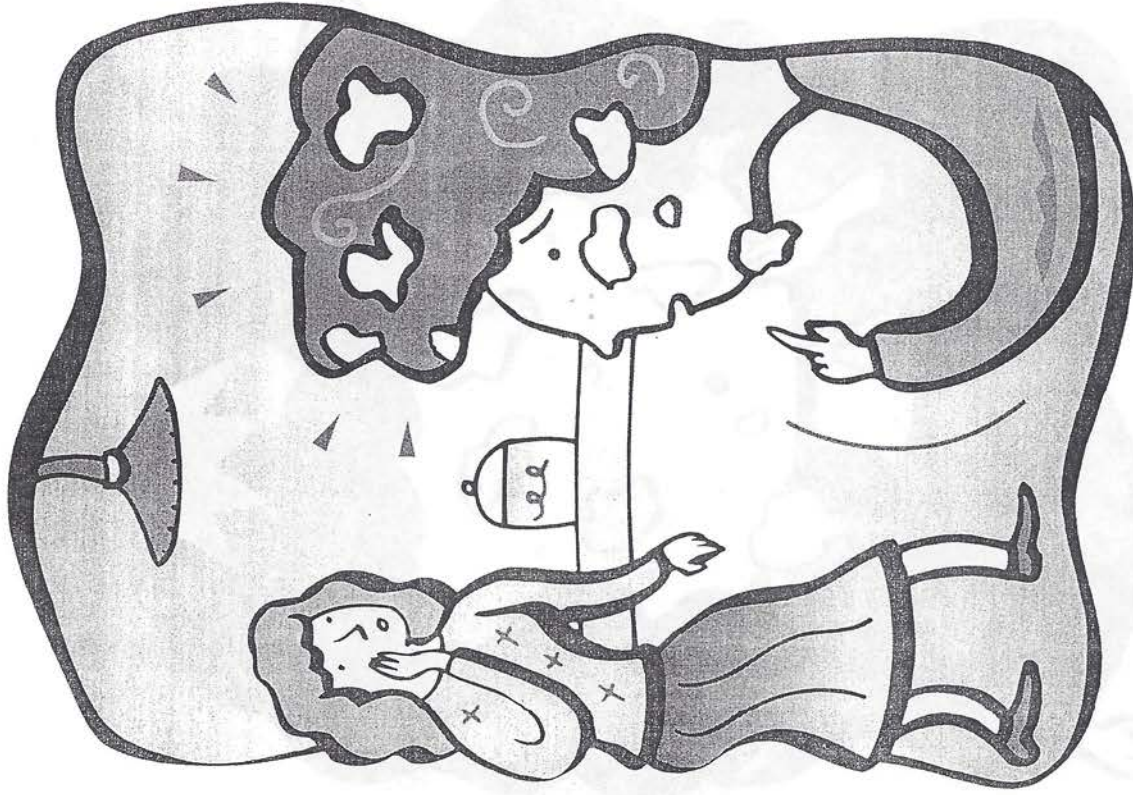
This is Sue.

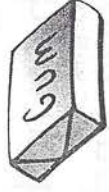
First Mom kisses Sue.

 Sue gets a trim.

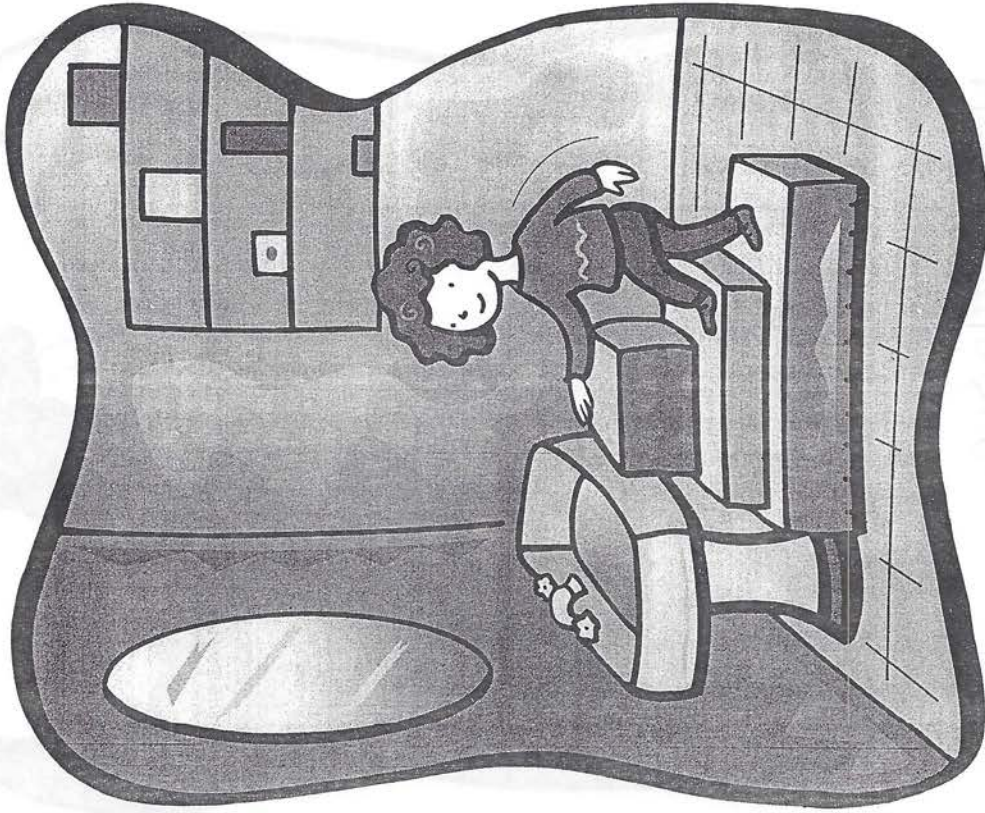


Sue finds her mother.
Mom knows what to do.

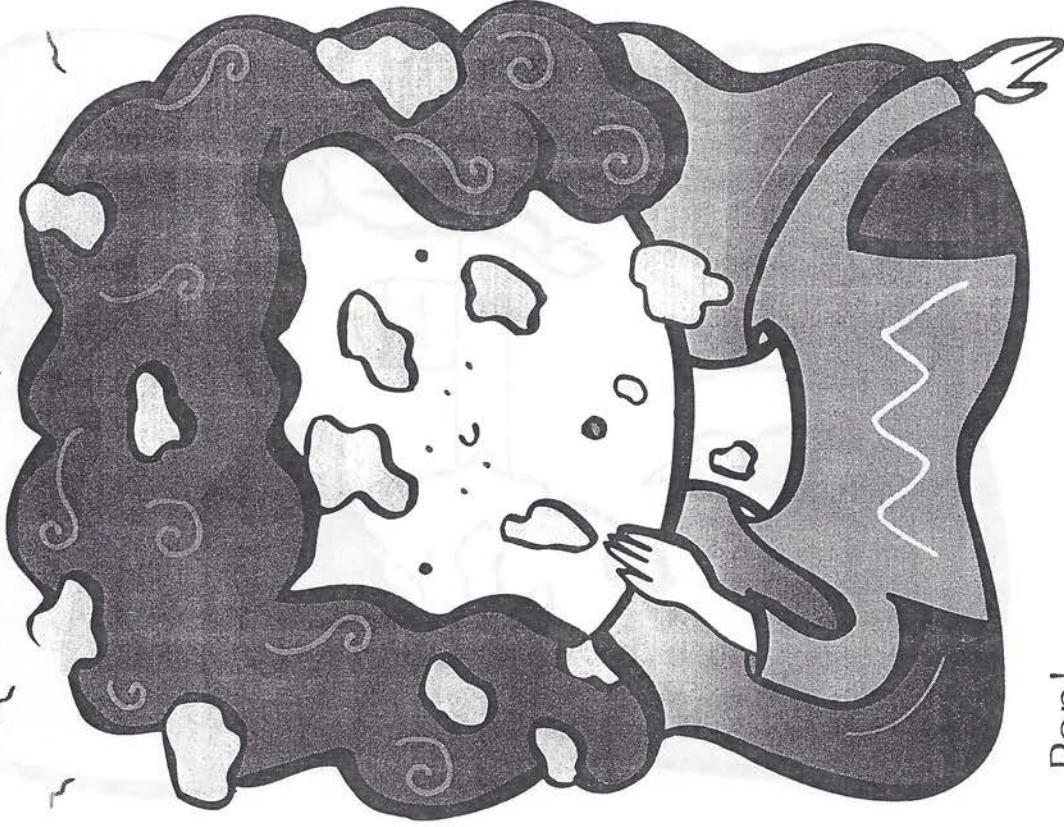


Here is little Sue.

Here's a clue:



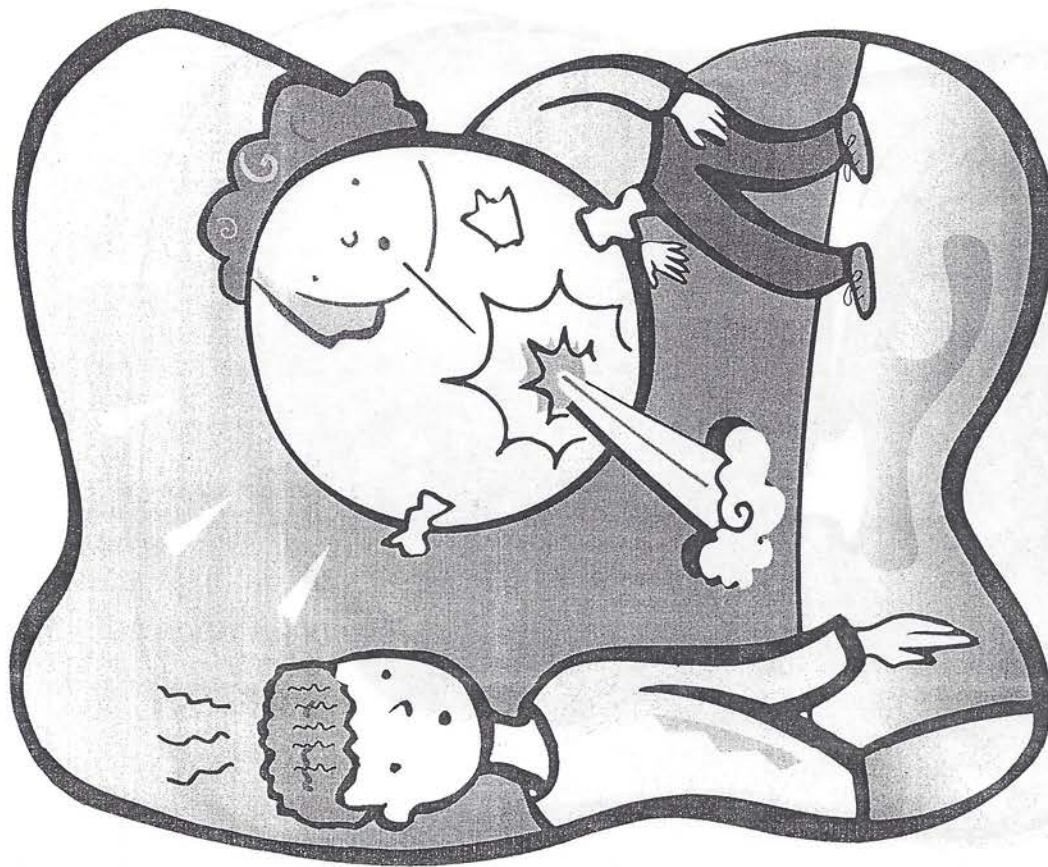


Sue can't see herself.

But she can't do it!

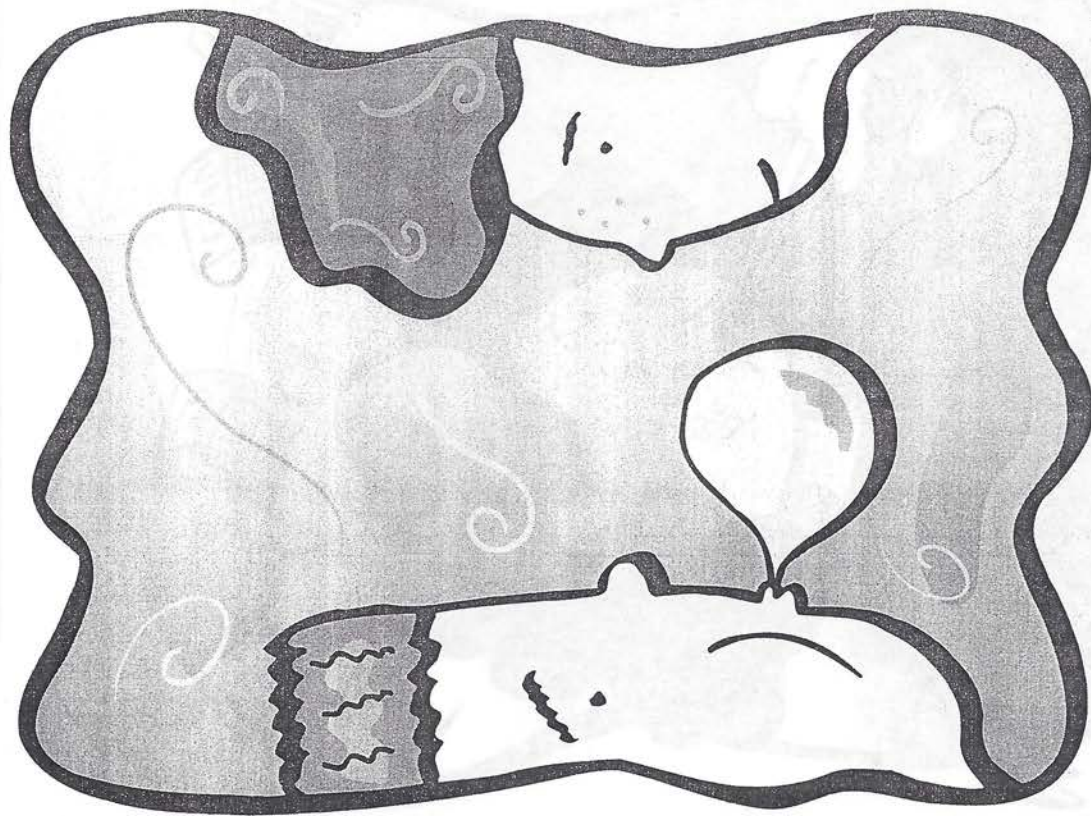


Pop!

Here's a clue:





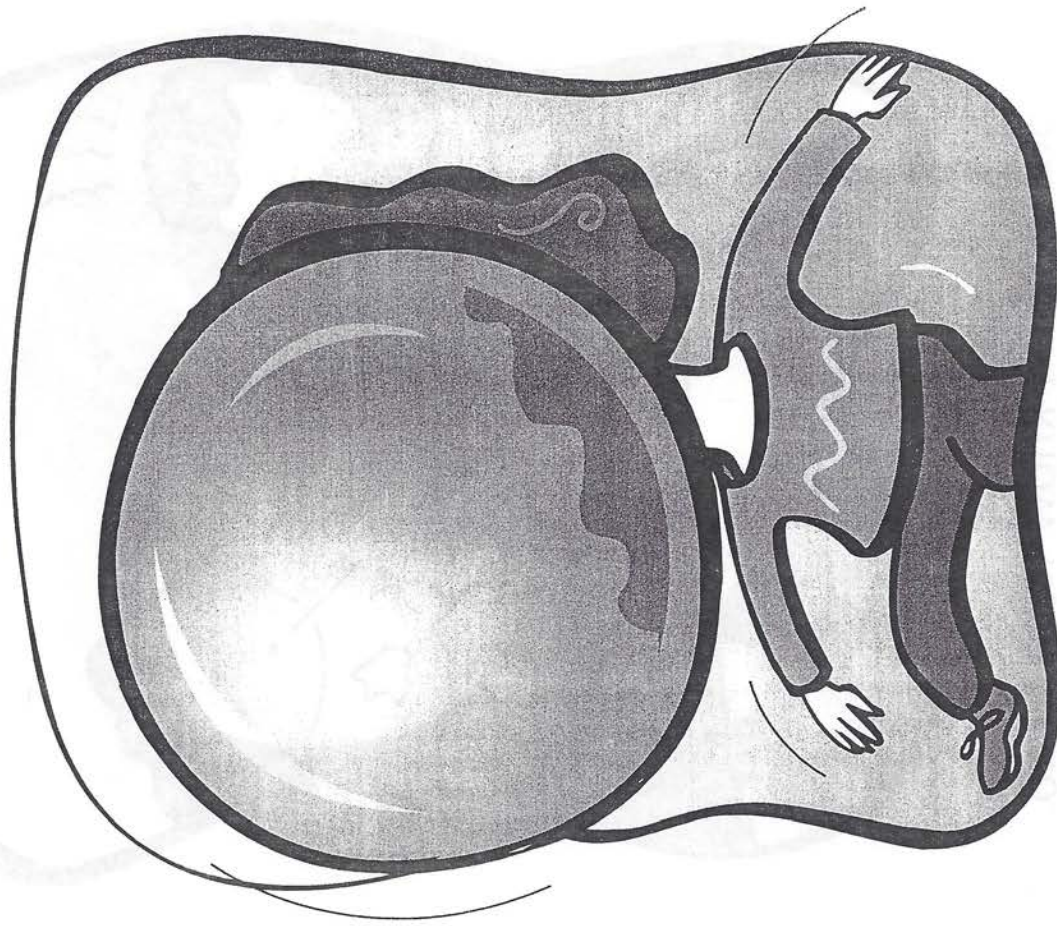
Sue doesn't know what to do.
